Updated Action Plan for Event & Security Procedures

Effective Immediately

Security Measures (1/2)

- Metal Detector Wands will be present
 - Upon entry each youth will be respectfully wanded by security and/or BTB staff
 - This is mandatory to enter the event
- Bags of any kind will not be permitted inside or during our event
 - A written notice by a guardian is required for only medical purposes
 - Small clutch purses are allowed but will be searched upon entry and can be searched at any point during the event
- Every person is subject to search
 - Upon entry into the event and/or during being wanded
 - Throughout the event at any time or reasons, a person can be respectfully searched

Security Measures (2/2)

- Two Security Guards will be present for the duration of the event
 - Bramlet Enterprises or Tim Wiles Security will be our security providers
 - For more: bramletenterprises.com

- The Security Guards are/will:
 - Be at the door(s) throughout the event
 - Be active and present throughout the event
 - Are armed and certified
 - Have their PA State Police Act 235 security certification
 - Have full discretion to search and/or remove any person from the event
 - Have Child Abuse History (Form CY-113) Clearance
 - Have PA State Police Background History (Form SP 4-164) Clearance

Chaperones

- Must be 18+
- Must have clearances:
 - Child Abuse History (Form CY-113)

- Any experience working with youth is encouraged
 - Coaching, education, nursing, etc.
- Will be present and active throughout the event
 - Stationed throughout the premises
 - Assist with refreshments and/or other activities
 - Primary to monitor and supervise the youth

Event Capacity

- A maximum capacity of between 200 and 250 youth will be set per event
- We are setting a ratio of 1:13 | staff/adult chaperone : youth
 - Meaning for every 13 youth there is one adult to monitor
 - Keystone Stars PA Childcare suggests a 1:15 ratio of adult to youth for grades 5-8
- Youth who have gotten in prior trouble at a/any Breakthrough-Butler function are not permitted to attend
 - Will be declined presale tickets
 - Will be asked one time to leave the event premises before security will take the necessary protective action
- Youth who are continuously in trouble in the community or school are also not permitted to attend a/any Breakthrough-Butler function
 - Will be declined presale tickets
 - Will be asked one time to leave the event premises before security will take the necessary protective action

Arriving at a Breakthrough Event

Upon arriving to our event each youth must:

- Enter the premises with a guardian
- The guardian will sign in youth on our sheet and provide a contact number(s)
 - Sign-in will be organized in alphabetical groupings
- If the youth is to leave with a friend or non-guardian
 - The youth's guardian must provide a written note detailing who the pick-up person will be for their youth
- The youth will show ticket / online proof of ticket
- Our ticket spreadsheet will be checked to mark attendance as present
 - We have a mass text system that will communicate any sudden changes
 - Breakthrough-Butler's number is 724-305-0720 text or call

During a Breakthrough Event

- During a youth's time at an event
 - Follow the direction of Nick Yannotty, Founder of Breakthrough-Butler
 - Follow the directions given by security, BTB staff, & chaperones
 - Follow the event and venue rules
 - Respect yourself, friends, peers, other people in attendance, & the venue
- Youth may be asked to leave or removed from the event if:
 - Failure to cooperate with rules
 - Disrespect shown towards Breakthrough personal, security, and/or chaperones
 - Damage to venue
 - Any inappropriate language and/or actions
 - Fighting of any kind, vaping/smoking, rough-housing
- If a person is removed from our event:
 - Guardians will be immediately notified
 - > Youth is not permitted to any Breakthrough-Butler event for the foreseeable future

Leaving a Breakthrough Event

- Upon leaving our event:
 - Guardian must enter the premises to sign-out their youth on the sign-out sheet
 - Guardian may be asked to present a photo ID during pick-up
 - > There is no re-entry, once a youth is checked out, they can not re-enter
 - > Youth must be checked out by a guardian
 - If youth is leaving with a friend, a note/email is required
 - Needs to state the adult who will be picking up the youth
 - Needs to be signed via email or signature by the youth's guardian
 - Our ticket spreadsheet will reflect to mark the youth as checked out

Event Tickets

- Event tickets will be available only presale to the event
- Tickets are sold presale at a come first basis
- Tickets sold online up until 10am day of the event
 - An event ticket link will be provided along with a QR code
 - For ticket/event info email breakthroughbutler@gmail.org

- Tickets will be sold at an in-person spot the week leading up to the event
 - Set pick-up (purchase) location
 - Set time for each day to purchase
 - i.e. a Saturday, February 4 event would have tickets sold at the designated location at a set time from Monday, January 30 to Friday, February 3
